Police substation building has a new owner. Alternate space within Soulard Farmer's Market also suggested.

Camera Program: in discussions with Anheuser-Busch about possible financial support of the Camera Program. Chair Reynolds talking with SSBD legal about partnership options.

Traffic Calming: according to the City, 12th street repaving is scheduled for 2026, which will then allow planning and construction work to commence on those intersections. Russell remains on hold due to the City of St Louis (improvements can't be engineered until streets are repaved, utilizing ward capital funds)

Car Clubs: New clubs are available at Julie Price's office. We will provide flyers and notices of this so neighbors know they are available.

Open board seat for residential property owner. Applicant Les Fields attended and spoke about interest in the position.
